Hybrid Teaching - Venue 1 (Large Theatres)

This teaching venue is equipped with a HD (Panasonic AVStream Camera) video camera and echo-cancelling 'boundary microphone' system for the purpose of facilitating recording and/or broadcast of teaching sessions. This can be achieved using the PC built in to the lectern and some of the preinstalled University of Galway ISS supported applications, as outlined below.

From the desktop, please open the application you wish to use.

Select the correct camera, microphone and speaker equipment

Once you have logged into the application you wish to use, and before you initiate a recording or video call, please ensure that you select the correct, camera, microphone and the speaker within the application's Audio Video settings.

- Select **Panasonic AVStream Camera 1** as your camera. You should see a picture of yourself when the above camera has been selected.
- Select EchoCancelling Speakerphone DMP Plus USB1 as your microphone.
- Select EchoCancelling Speakerphone DMP Plus USB1 as your speaker.

If you wish to record – don't forget to activate this in your chosen application.

Note: The microphones and cameras are oriented to only capture the audio of lecturers standing within 1.5m of the lectern.
